L. E.A.D. is recruiting for School Direct places in 2014-2015. The L.E.A.D. Teaching School Alliance will help equip trainee teachers with the unique set of skills and attributes needed to teach in vibrant urban settings.

Entry requirements

You are required on entry to hold a UK degree or equivalent qualification.

Other requirements:

In addition you must hold English Language and Mathematics at GCSE - grade C or above. Applicants for primary teaching must also hold Science at GCSE - grade C or above.

What will it achieve?

Having completed the course participants will:

- be awarded the prestigious University of Nottingham PGCE and Qualified Teacher Status
- and up to 60 Masters credits (towards a 180-credit MA Education degree)

What does it involve?

You will follow your school calendar and the timetable at the University, working in school four days per week throughout the whole school year. Each Friday you attend the University to learn as part of a professional cohort of beginning teachers and spend the rest of the week learning to teach in your placement school.

How do I apply?
